



Terms & Conditions

1. Mooring, car, dinghy and trailer parking and launching are subject to the Company's Regulations and Terms of business. Copies available on request.
2. Charges for berths and mooring payable in advance. Payment for Annual or Winter charges may be made by Monthly Bankers Standing Order, details on request.
3. All berths booked and charged at Annual or Winter rates are done so on the understanding that the berth is booked for this period and refunds or credits cannot be given if the berth is not used for the period booked or charged for.
4. Charges are based on the extreme length overall. This includes bowsprit and bumpkin if not housed, and any other overhang fore or aft including: pulpit, pushpit, rudder, boom, self steering gear, outboard, Z drive, davits and dinghies hung in davits.
5. Charges for berths and moorings relate to a maximum beam of 3.75m. Where beam exceeds this, 1 m will be added to the overall length for every .25m excess.
6. All these charges are exclusive of handling charges for adjusting moorings, slipping, laying up, relaunching, stepping and unstepping masts.
7. Charges for pontoon berths include 1 small dinghy which must be stowed on deck or left ashore. They must not be left alongside owners craft or on the pontoons. If carried in davits refer to note 4 above.
8. Every vessel must have its name clearly marked, this applies particularly to dinghies and smaller craft.
9. Bookings for pontoon berths will only be accepted for Annual or Winter periods and these will be charged accordingly.
